Subject: Appeal - Public Service Management Pension Plan Board

On October 24, 1991, you attended a hearing against a decision of the Minister in establishing the cost of service with the Department of National Defense. Mr. J. Millard, Payroll & Pensions Division of Alberta Treasury, appeared for the Minister.

In pursuing the issue, it became clear that you were requesting a remedy that is outside the Board's jurisdiction - there is no reciprocal agreement between the Department of National Defense and the Public Service Management Pension Plan. It was pointed out that the Board could only hear your case if it was an appeal against the costing of the service you were attempting to establish. It was evident that your grievance was with your employing department and did not fall within the legislation governing the plan or the Board. As a result, the Board did not make a decision on your case.
